Ms. Tetzlaff's Kindergarten Class

Hello to my kindergarten families! It is so hard to believe that the month of MAY is already here! This month we will be working on our spring theme, farm theme and community helpers.

<u>Literacy:</u> we will keep working on letter recognition as well as learning how to recognize, form and print small words. We will continue working on our rhyming skills and introducing word families to strengthen rhyming skills. Eg 'at' family(mat, cat, bat, sat,hat).

<u>Numeracy:</u> The kindergarten students will continue to work on number sense through counting, recognizing, printing, sorting and making sets with numbers O-10. Our next unit will be Measurement. The students will learn the concept of measuring and comparing lengths. We will use non-standard items to measure. (ex. blocks, paper clips, etc.).

We will continue to explore and communicate that money has features to represent its value.

Social Studies: We will be learning about 'Community Helpers'.

<u>Science</u> - We will take advantage of the wonderful changes that happen during the Spring season by exploring plant and animal life cycles. This ties into 'Earth Systems' where students examine and describe their surrounding environments.

Language Arts: We continue to work on improving our reading and writing skills as we work daily on our various classroom activities.
