



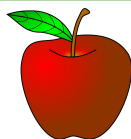

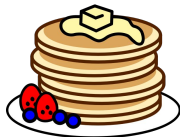
Pancake Breakfast

Things to Keep in Mind

School starts at 8:24 am. If your child will be absent or late **please call or email the school 403-556-2429** as attendance remains on their student record until graduation. If we have not heard from you before 9am you will receive a call from our automated attendance system.

Both indoor and outdoor footwear are required for all students.

The Round Up will be emailed to you on the first Thursday of the month. This will be your reminder on the activities and lunch options for the month. We won't forget to add what is going on in the community!

Weekly Reminders will be emailed Monday mornings. (If the Round Up is published Thursday, you will not get an email the following Monday).

Monies for Hot Dogs, are to be paid no later than the prior Monday. **Hot Dog orders payable online only** if you have not created an account please do so at www.reed ranch.ca under the quicklink tab. Your child's number is the Student ID on the **school fee invoice coming home next week**, Again if you need help just call Ms. Bennett.

YEARLY DEMOGRAPHICS These are **VERY** important so we are able to contact you should we need if your child is sick. This also requires you to give consent so your child will be able to use our chromebooks. If you have not completed it through your email, please contact Ms Bennett to have it resent. Thank you to those that already done so.

When selecting items for your child's lunch, we ask you to consider warm up time on items. Keeping warm up times **under one minute**, allows all students in the room time to use the microwave and have as much time as possible to enjoy their lunch. There are changes to the way we engage with parents when sensitive topics are taught in classrooms

Starting in September 2025, Alberta Education is requiring that all school divisions including Chinook's Edge School Division notify parents about instruction related to subject matter dealing primarily or explicitly with gender identity, sexual orientation or human sexuality.

You can expect that your child's school will provide you with a form appropriate to your child's grade level. This notification provides parents with the option to 'opt in' their child for instruction related to the subject matter.
